
Your Excellency:

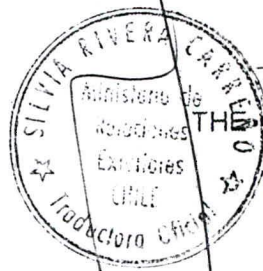


