As you are probably aware, Miami suffered quite a bit of damage from Hurricane Andrew. Miami-Dade had over 20 million dollars in damages. Our students suffered even more. We are attempting to raise monies for their education and we need your help.

Miami-Dade Community College is the largest Community College in the United States with an unduplicated student head count of over 70,000. We have more minority students enrolled at Miami-Dade than all but two other colleges or universities in the United States. We also enroll more students from foreign countries than any other American college.
