As a person concerned about human rights, I welcome your opposition to the death penalty. This form of punishment has now been abolished in many countries as respect for human rights of all citizens is recognised.

I have come to hear of the case of Juan Dominigo Salvo Zúñiga who has been found guilty of a serious crime of murder, and has been sentenced to death.

I write to you to appeal to your excellency to exercise your power of clemency in this case and to have this sentence commuted to that of life imprisonment as was originally handed down by the criminal court in the town of Vicuna in November 1991.
