Excelencia Sr Presidente de la República,

As a member of Amnesty International I am writing to you to express my concern about the extra-judicial execution of Mapuche Indians by the military under the previous regime. These include the deaths of Antonio Arinao Morales, Pedro Millaten Huenchúnur, Samuel Alfonso Catatun Lincoeo, Nelson Curinir Lincoeo, José Llaulen Antúlar and Juan Checigüeppán Levumilla. I am concerned that the investigation of these and other crimes is being prevented by Decree Law 2191 I appreciate that the events of which I write took place long before your Government came to power but I believe that the perpetrators of such atrocities should be brought to justice. I therefore ask you as President of Chile to repeal this law and ensure that these crimes are thoroughly investigated. May I express my thanks for taking the time to read this letter and hope that you feel able to alleviate my concerns.
