We call for the total abolition of the death penalty in Chile in line with the worldwide trend (over 40 per cent of all countries have now abolished the death in law or in practice). We state that abolition would ensure long-term respect for the human rights of all peoples, regardless of nationality, which the death penalty clearly violates.
