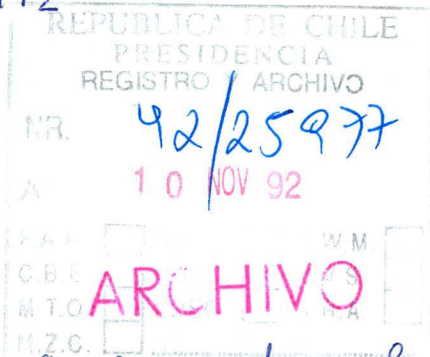

I am writing as a member of Amnesty International to express my serious concern about the seeming impunity of those responsible for human rights violations during the former military government of your country.

In particular I would urge you to ensure that justice is done in the case of Alfonso Cerro Oyarce. His case is representative of a large number of human rights abuses which I'm sure that you and your fellow countrymen must share a desire to see openly brought to justice.

I urge you to ensure that his case is not transferred to military jurisdiction, as this

could well lead to the blocking of the case.

I also urge you to consider repealing the 1978 Amnesty Law (Decree Law 2191) which is obstructing full judicial inquiry.

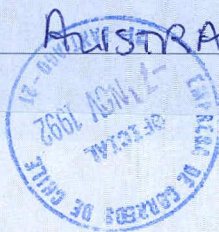
