Dear People,

I am writing you in accordance with prophetic utterances from the Holy Bible; the Old Testament, New Testament, and the Revelation of Jesus Christ.

As sure as the words of the prophets have been fulfilled throughout the ages, and as sure as our Lord Jesus Christ came to earth in the flesh, and was brutally put to death on the cross, and rose again to be seated at the right hand of our Heavenly Father, and as sure as the words of the Revelation have been fulfilled to this present day; I proclaim to you:

The great and terrible day of our Lord's return is soon. Again, surely I tell you, our Lord is returning soon.

To fulfil the words of our Lord God, as written in Isaiah 30.8-14, I am delivering to you these words from the Revised Standard Version Translated from the original tongues, being the version set forth A.D. 1611, Revised A.D. 1881-1885 and 1901, compared with the most ancient authorities and revised A.D. 1952;

8 And now, go, write it before them on
a tablet,
and inscribe it in a book,
that it may be for the time to come
as a witness for ever.
9 For they are a rebellious people,
lying sons,
sons who will not hear
the instruction of the Lord;
10 who say to the seers, "See not";
and to the prophets, "Prophecy not
to us what is right;
speak to us smooth things,
prophecy illusions,
11 leave the way, turn aside from the path,
let us hear no more of the Holy One
of Isreal."
12 Therefore thus says the Holy One of
Isreal,

"Because you despise this word,
and trust in oppression and per-
verseness,
and rely on them;
13 therefore this iniquity shall be to
you
like a break in high wall, bulging
out, and about to collapse,
whose crash comes suddenly, in an
instant;
14 and its breaking is like that of a
potters vessel
which is smashed so ruthlessly
that among its fragments not a sherd
is found
with which to take fire from the
hearth,
or to dip up water out of the cis-
tern."

Jeremiah 25.30-38

"You, therefore, shall
prophecy against them all these words,
and say to them:

'The Lord will roar from on high,
and from his holy habitation utter
his voice;
he will roar mightily against his fold,
and shout, like those who tread
grapes,
against all the inhabitants of the
earth.

The clamor will resound to the ends of the
earth,

for the Lord has an indictment against
the nations;

he is entering into judgement with all flesh,
and the wicked he will put to the
sword,

says the Lord.'

"Thus says the Lord of hosts:

Behold, evil is going forth
from nation to nation,
and a great tempest is stirring
from the farthest parts of the
earth.

"And those slain by the
Lord on that day shall extend from one
end of the earth to the other. They shall
not be lamented, or gathered, or buried;
they shall be dung on the surface of the
ground.

"Wail, you shepherds, and cry,
and roll in ashes, you lords of the
flock,
for the days of your slaughter and
dispersion have come,
and you shall fall like choice rams.
No refuge will remain for the shep-
herds,
nor escape for the lords of the
flock.
Hark, the cry of shepherds,
and the wail of the lords of the
flock.
For the Lord is despoiling their
pasture,
and the peaceful folds are dev-
astated,
because of the fierce anger of the
Lord.
Like a lion he has left his covert,
for the land has become a waste
because of the sword of the oppressor,
and because of his fierce anger."

Matthew 24.3-14

3 As he sat on the mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the close of the age?" 4 And Jesus answered them, "Take heed that no one leads you astray. 5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ.' and they will lead many astray. 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that you are not alarmed; for this must take place, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places: all this is but the beginning of the sufferings.

9 "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation, and put you to death; and you will be hated by all nations for my names sake. 10 And then many will fall away, and betray one another, and hate one another. 11 And many false prophets will arise and lead many astray. 12 And because wickedness is multiplied, most men's love will grow cold. 13 But he who endures to the end will be saved.

14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached throughout the whole world, as a testimony to all nations; and then the end will come.
