Dear Mr. President,

I have learned of the extradition procedures against **OSWALDO ROMO MENA**, which should enable him to stand trial in your country on charges of serious human rights abuses during the military government.

May I respectfully urge that the case of **ALFONSO CHANFREAU**, at present being investigated by a civilian judge, Gloria Olivares, in which Oswaldo Romo Mena is believed implicated, is not handed over to the Military Court. May I ask that this, and other cases of human rights violations including disappearances, be dealt with by civilian courts.

May I respectfully urge that the Amnesty Law of 1978 be finally repealed, allowing proper investigations into disappearances and the prosecutions of military personnel involved. May I point out that the cases of disappearances are "continuing crimes" and remain so until those who have disappeared are either found alive or their remains are established.
