Referring to previous letter dated 1992-06-27.


Juan Domingo Salvo Zuniga, 46, a Chilean peasant, was sentenced to death by an Appeals Court in April 1992.

Amnesty International opposes the death penalty as a violation of the right to life and the right not to be subjected to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

As a member in Amnesty International, and according to the above, I am respectfully

- welcoming Your Excellency's opposition to death penalty and respectfully requesting that You exercise your power of clemency and commutes the death sentence against Juan Domingo Salvo Zuniga.
- calling for the total abolition of the death penalty in Chile in line with the worldwide trend.
