

A pesar de que ha sido mi sincero propósito, debido a nuestro activo programa en esta ciudad y a otras limitaciones prácticas, no he podido visitarlo personalmente para felicitarlo por la importante contribución que su gobierno y Su Excelencia han hecho a nuestros esfuerzos comunes por concretar algunos aspectos

Como es de conocimiento de Su Excelencia, la alfombra de yute está hecha de fibra natural de yute propicia para el medio ambiente, la cual es el pilar del 40 por ciento de la población de Bangladesh. La razón por la que traje específicamente alfombras de yute como obsequios, es crear conciencia, a través de Su Excelencia, entre la gente que conoce y se preocupa del medio ambiente en su país, acerca de las cualidades propicias para el medio ambiente que el yute posee como fibra, en comparación con aquellas de las fibras sintéticas contaminantes que también se utilizan para fabricar alfombras, forros para alfombras, materiales de embalaje y otros productos similares.

El aumento del consumo de estas fibras sintéticas contaminantes está presentando una grave amenaza para el yute. Además, el yute está expuesto a otros



peligros debido a que el aumento en el nivel del mar reducirá la zona de cultivo ya que tiene que competir con el arroz y otros cultivos en un país como Bangladesh con una aguda escasez de tierra.

Por lo tanto, creemos que si no se considera y apoya en forma especial el aumento del consumo de yute y artículos de yute y su protección contra la amenaza del efecto de invernadero, hará que el desarrollo sustentable sea aún más difícil en Bangladesh.

Aprovecho la oportunidad para reiterar a Su Excelencia las seguridades de mi más alta consideración.
