I am a Swedish engineer and member of Amnesty International. Now I respectfully appeal to Your Excellency to exercise Your power of clemency and commute the death sentence against **Juan Salvo Zúñiga**.

Amnesty International opposes the death penalty in all cases without reservation, on humanitarian grounds.

I should stress that my concern is based entirely on respect for human life and is not political. I believe we must take every possible step to eradicate violence against human beings, including the taking of life by society itself. It is in this spirit that I urge You to take the lead in ending death sentences and executions in Chile.
