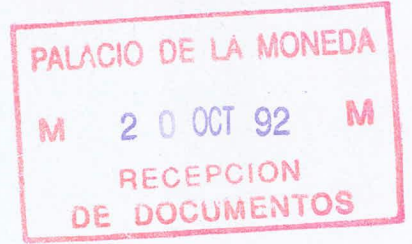

It grieves me to find that the murderers of Nelson Curinir are covered and protected by a law passed by the government of Chile in 1978 which exonerates all those who as authors, accomplices, or accessories ~~to crimes~~ had been responsible for crimes committed during the state of siege imposed in the country between September 11 and March 10, 1978. These criminals must be brought to justice! Murder is an unexcusable crime no matter who commits it, and every life is sacred, no matter the race, color or religion. Thank-you.

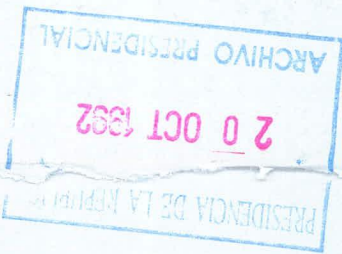


AEROGRAMME • VIA AIRMAIL • PAR AVION
